Asking questions at an interview is a great way of showing an interest in the company but also an opportunity for you to find out more information to help you make a decision yourself on whether the company/role is right for you

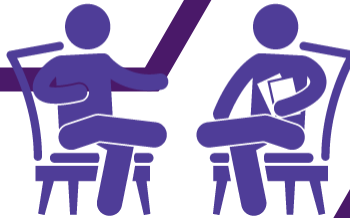
What potential opportunities may there be further down the line for the right candidate who performs well in this role?

What is the next step and at what stage will there be a decision on the role?

What is the company organisational structure and how does this role fit into the organisation as a whole?

What is the size of the team the role is in?

What are the plans for the company going forward? Are there any immediate plans in the pipeline?

What is the company environment/culture like?

Can you describe what a typical day in this role would involve?

What will the training for this role be and is there a specific timescale for training?

What is the reason for this position being vacant?

How long have you been at this company? What makes it a good place to work?
